

Biography of Reverend Anthony Evans

As president of the National Black Church Initiative (NBCI), Rev. Anthony Evans oversees a powerful national network of 16,000 faith-based communities. NBCI's primary mission is to promote good health practices through educational seminars, comprehensive literature about various illnesses and diseases, and community outreach.

In 1991, Rev. Evans and a group of ministers from various denominations in the Washington-Metro area launched the DC Black Church Initiative to address health disparities and the urgent need for expanded social services in the District. Word of the organization's innovative social ministry through its 24 Health Church Model spread quickly, and scores of churches across the country joined to form a national network.
